- 4 - Providing feedback through our **Comments box** and **surveys**.

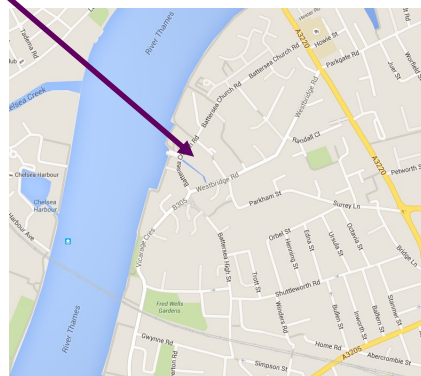
